PHYSICAL EDUCATION	Two semesters of PE are required to graduate from 8 th grade. One semester of P.E. needs to be taken in 7 th and 8 th grade. Students may choose to take additional P.E.	COMPUTER I	Keyboarding and Word Processing. One semester was required in 7 th grade. If new to the CSCS, students will be required to take it in 8 th grade.
FINE ART ELECTIVES	Choose 2 unless taking choir or band.	INTRO TO WEIGHTLIFTING	Students will learn how to properly lift weights to build strength, coordination, and endurance while learning about human anatomy and exercise physiology.
ART I	No prerequisite.	SPANISH	This course is for 7 th or 8 th graders desiring a one semester introduction to Spanish.
ART II	Art I is NOT a prerequisite.	Life Lab	This course teaches students basic life skills to help them navigate life. Skills such as finance, car maintenance, meal planning, cooking and sewing will be taught.
ART III	Art I or Art II prerequisite and instructor approval	Leadership	Students will explore and study what servant leadership looks like and what their leadership strengths are.
Digital Graphic Design	Students will learn the basics of design and important techniques. Students will learn about color theory, typography, and many other elements used together to produce eye-catching artwork	STEM I	Students will explore a variety of engineering applications through hands-on activities and team challenges.
DRAMA PERFORMANCE	Students will study and practice the skills of auditioning, character-building, scene acting, writing, improvisation, and behind-the-scenes work.	STEM II	Students continue the engineering design process as they move into higher level projects involving electronics and circuitry, robotics, cybersecurity, and more.
