



ONLINE COURSE OPPORTUNITIES

Information for Parents & Students

CSCS is committed to providing meaningful and flexible learning opportunities for our students. Our online course options allow us to expand offerings beyond in-seat traditional classes, to include additional computer courses, world language courses, Lions Online classes, and dual credit opportunities.

Although these courses are online, students will attend a CSCS classroom daily with a CSCS instructor who provides academic support, technical assistance, and accountability, helping students build the skills needed for success in online learning.

Online Computer Courses (Grades 9-12)

CSCS offers online computer courses through CodeHS at no additional cost. Options include Computer Science, Creative Computing, Cybersecurity, Programming, Web Design, and Web Development. Additional course options are available. Please contact the counseling office for more information.

Online World Languages (Grades 10-12)

Students may enroll in online language courses not offered in-seat at CSCS for an additional fee. Languages include French, German, Hebrew, Greek, Latin, ASL, and Chinese. If a student is interested in a language other than the ones listed, please contact the counseling office.

Online Dual Credit Courses (Grades 11-12)

Dual Credit courses are available to juniors and seniors through faith-based partner universities. These courses provide a cost-effective option, with fees ranging from \$300–\$850 per course compared to traditional college courses which may cost \$1,500 - \$3,000 per course. Textbooks are not included in course fees and must be purchased separately by the student. Transferability is not guaranteed, and families are encouraged to confirm credit acceptance with prospective colleges. Find a sample list of available courses in this packet. Online Trade Dual Credit Courses (Grades 11-12)

Students who are interested in the trades will have the opportunity to explore career options and certifications in their area of interest while still in high school. These courses are offered through Southeastern University and carry a fee of \$200 per credit hour. Some courses may require students to purchase a textbook as well. Lions Online Courses (Grades 9-12)

Students may request to take a Lions Online course as long as the course they are requesting is not offered in-seat and is not needed to meet graduation requirements. Additional fees apply. Students may meet with a counselor to discuss scheduling options and class availability.

Online Student Profile & Course Conditions

The student requesting to take an online course and his/her parent will be asked to read this profile and sign that they agree with these conditions when they complete the **Online Course Request Form**.

A student is well-suited for a teacher-monitored Online Course if the student...

- **Has and maintains a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 or above (2.5 or above for trade courses).**
- **Has no attendance issues, including excessive tardiness.**
- **Is an independent learner.**
 - *As an online student, I plan to take full responsibility for my coursework.*
 - *I am a self-motivated and self-disciplined individual; I can work independently with little direction.*
- **Knows how to manage his/her time effectively.**
 - *I am not a procrastinator. I like to get things done today and not tomorrow.*
 - *I am comfortable spending five or more hours each week to review course lectures/videos, complete course assignments, participate in chats and threaded discussions, etc.*
- **Is a proficient reader and communicator.**
- **Understands acceptable online behavior.**
- **Does not get frustrated easily.**
 - *I understand that I may have to wait 24 hours for questions to be answered by my online instructor.*
- **Understands that all coursework must be completed by the last day of in-seat finals each semester.**

Parents should agree with the above statements and understand the following conditions...

- My student will incur additional fees when taking an Online World Language, Online Dual Credit, Online Trade Dual Credit, and/or Lions Online course.
- I understand that if my student drops an online course after the CSCS drop/add deadline, we may be responsible for all course fees and related expenses.
- My student must still have 6 credit-bearing courses each semester to be considered a full-time student, even if they take an online summer course.
- I understand that failure to complete online courses according to the specified timeline may jeopardize sports eligibility and/or my student's ability to graduate from CSCS.
- I understand that for Online Dual Credit courses, transferability is not guaranteed, even by the sponsoring college. It is my responsibility to verify that credits will transfer to the college program of my student's choice.
- I understand that since textbooks are not included in Online Dual Credit course fees, I am responsible to purchase textbooks for my student's dual credit course(s) which may run \$35 - \$275 per book.
- I understand that registration for online courses will take place in the online lab with administrative supervision after the start of school. While registering for Online Dual Credit or Online Trade Dual Credit Courses, my student may need assistance from a teacher, principal, and/or counselor. I give permission for that person to act as temporary guardian to complete the registration process.
- I understand that a CSCS teacher, principal, and/or counselor will need to see my child's progress on his/her online course(s). Therefore, I give them permission to ask my student to open his/her online account and show all coursework, discussion posts, and grades associated with his/her course(s).
