



# 2025 – 2026 Elementary Classroom Supply Lists

## Kindergarten

Mrs. Jenny Cosner

- 1 - Plastic pencil box (Please label with child's name)
- 1 – Package of 12 #2 pencils, sharpened (Ticonderoga if possible)
- 2 – Pink erasers
- 1 – Pack of 4 fine-tipped dry erase markers (preferably black)
- 1 – Pack of crayons (24 count)
- 1 – Pack of 10 markers (Crayola Classic Colors, washable)
- 1 – Bottle of 4 oz. Elmer's Liquid Glue
- 2 – Glue sticks
- 2 – Two-pocket plastic folders (Please label with child's name)
- 2 – Two- pocket plastic folders with prongs (Please label with child's name)
- 1 – Pair of scissors (Please label with child's name)
- 1 – Water bottle with **closing lid** for **daily use** (to be take home to clean on weekends)
- 1 – Backpack, big enough to hold 9 x 12 papers and library books
- 1 – Small headphones (no ear buds) for computer, in a sealable bag or case (Please label with child's name)

## First Grade

- 1 – Set of computer headphones for computer class (in a bag with child's name on it)
  - 1 – Box of small, quart-sized Ziploc bags
  - 2 – Boxes of tissue
  - 2 – Block-type, handheld erasers
  - 1 – Box of colored pencils (or the colors red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown, and black)
  - 1 – Handheld pencil sharpener (Please label with child's name)
  - 1 – Children's scissors (Please label with child's name)
  - 1 – Pencil **bag** (a zippable bag; no boxes please) (Please label with child's name)
  - 1 – 12-inch ruler with **cm and inches – it must have cm and inches both!** (Please label with child's name)
  - 4 – Folders (Please label with child's name)
    - 1 **red** folder that is sturdy **plastic** and has **brads** for 3-hole-punch paper
    - 1 **blue** folder that is sturdy **plastic** and has **brads** for 3-hole-punch paper
    - 1 **yellow** folder that is sturdy **plastic** and has **brads** for 3-hole-punch paper
    - 1 folder of **any** type and/or color
  - 1 – Water bottle **with closing lid** (that student can close and that **stays** closed) (Please label with child's name). Students need a water bottle with them at school every day!
  - 1 – Backpack **to fit lunch box and folder** and all items students may bring to school
  - 1 – Reusable plastic, sturdy, hangable bag (**large enough to hold child's snow gear**) (Please label with child's name)
    - If you would like to send this later, with your child's snow gear in it, that works well
  - 1 – Set of snow gear: Snow boots, waterproof gloves, winter hat, snow pants, and waterproof coat.
  - 1 – Sweater **and** 1 coat at school every day. (You may send these to leave at school or send them with your child each morning.) No matter what the weather says, please ensure your child has **both a sweater and a coat** at school every day.)
- Please only send shoes with laces if your child can tie them OR send tied shoes with lace clips so they stay tied all day. Otherwise, Velcro or slip-on shoes are a great option.

If you would like to send this later, with your child's snow gear in it, that works well

1 – Set of snow gear: Snow boots, waterproof gloves, winter hat, snow pants, and waterproof coat.

- If you are able to help provide some extra supplies, we are usually short on reusable bags, yellow plastic folders with brads, and brown and yellow colored pencils. We will also use smooth stones, paper plates, cotton balls, PlayDoh, sandpaper, gelatin packet of Jell-O, and plastic spoons for science projects. If you are able to send any of those in, it would be greatly appreciated.
